The project

iCom is an Erasmus Plus project which aims to compensate for the lack of formulaic language-based teaching materials by creating a handbook for teachers, an app for learners that uses all authentic sources from target languages, and an Open Educational Resource for teachers which provides practical teaching materials for formulaic language. The project is coordinated by Eurospeak (United Kingdom).



Looking into the spring

Our project is approaching is completion, with the end of May being the end. In these final months we will be focusing in finalizing all of our remaining Intellectual Outputs, as well as in organizing our Multiplier Events in all project countries.

Intellectual Output 2: the iCom App

Our app is an Android mobile game that focuses in improving the formulaic language competences in a fun way. It is available in English, Italian, Spanish, Latvian, Russian and German and it includes videos from each country's pop culture (movies, TV series, commercials, music clips).

The users can download the game and start playing - no register needed. They will then be able to select their preferred language and watch videos with subtitles, with the formulaic language phrases highlighted in yellow. The explanation for the phrases, as well as the video sources, can be found in the text box beneath the video. Based on the video they just watched, the users will then have to test their knowledge by taking a short quiz, with multiple choice and fill-the-gap exercises. In the end of each exercise, they will be able to see their final score, as well as the correct answer for each question. We hope that both language teachers and learners can benefit from our app, which is, as always, free and available online. To download it, scan the QR code below!
